

POLICY - 4.1.1 - FACILITY USE - GENERAL
SCOPE - ALL PREMISES AND FACILITIES

Though the Fire District is recognized as a public entity, and as such, the facilities belonging to the District may be regarded as public property, it must be understood by all persons that fire stations are not in the same category as other public buildings. And, that due to their very nature, there are some areas which are not open to the public without proper authorization.

Persons of the general public have permission to be on District premises and to enter those facilities only to conduct such business as may be appropriate between citizens and District personnel, and only in designated public areas.

Employees, voluntary members, and board members have permission to enter any District owned facility for any reason. Employees and voluntary members are restricted from entry to certain designated areas of some facilities, unless otherwise authorized.

Employees, voluntary members, and board members may invite guests into the facilities, provided they are willing to assume full responsibility for those invited.

All persons entering and/or using District owned facilities shall comply with all rules and policies concerning conduct while on the premises.
