

POLICY - 5.1.2 - STAND-BY SERVICE CHARGES
SCOPE - BOARD OF DIRECTORS & ALL PERSONNEL

PURPOSE: To establish a standard approach for the provision of, and billing for, stand-by services to all parties requesting such services.

POLICY: Based upon the availability of resources, the District will make reasonable efforts to accommodate all requests for stand-by services submitted by other entities for events sponsored by those entities.

CONDITIONS:

1. All requests for stand-by services shall be approved by the Fire Chief, or designee, prior to scheduling.
2. Each piece of apparatus shall be staffed by at least two (2) qualified members of the department.
3. It must be understood, by all parties, that an emergency alarm shall take precedence over stand-by duty. If appropriate, stand-by will resume once the emergency has been resolved.
4. Stand-by services are available only within the boundaries of the fire district.
5. Billing for this service will be adjusted according to the nature of the organization or entity making the request. See schedule below. Time accounting will begin upon arrival at the event on an hourly basis and will be prorated to the next quarter hour for actual time spent.
